

Maribyrnong Primary School Music Term 4 Overview



Term 4 Learning 2024

Junior and senior music programs at Maribyrnong include games and activities, that involve listening, moving, dancing and the playing of tuned and untuned instruments. Students are given opportunities to work in small groups, compose and perform for their classmates if they feel comfortable.

This term we will focus on:

Kindergarten – sharing ideas and feelings about the music we experience or perform, recognising the musical elements (dynamics, tempo, pitch, timbre) in the music we play and listen to, in-tune singing, beat/rhythm, creating a short composition, deriving and notating simple rhythmic patterns found in known song material.

Year 1/2 (with Negin Kamali) – sharing ideas about the music we experience or perform, developing listening skills, recognising and using the musical elements (dynamics, texture, tempo, pitch, rhythm and timbre) when listening to, improvising and composing music.

Year 3/4/LSUA – how to combine the elements of music to compose and perform a piece of music that communicates ideas, developing music reading skills, playing different parts in pieces of music using instruments such as a recorder, xylophone, marimba, djembe and other auxiliary percussion.

LSU - beat/rhythm, exploring the musical elements (dynamics, tempo, pitch, timbre) in the music we play and listen to, playing and moving in time, each voice having its own distinct sound, creating a short composition, deriving, and notating simple rhythmic patterns found in the known song material.

Choir – preparing for their performances at the Crescendo Concert and end of year School Picnic Concert.

Year 5 and 6 Bands – continuing to learn a varied repertoire of new music, notes, and music theory. There will be two more performance opportunities this year, at the Crescendo Concert and end of year School Picnic Concert. Please see the dates below.
